SCHOLARSHIP

The Laurie Pallett/Metalworks Institute Scholarship provides two recipients each with a \$5,000.00 tuition scholarship for the Music Business Program at Metalworks Institute of Sound & Music Production. The selected recipients will also receive a one year membership to the Mississauga Arts Council and will be required to complete 20 hours of volunteer work with the Mississauga Arts Council throughout the duration of their studies. *Other education related costs, including the balance of tuition, textbooks, supplies, housing and any other fees associated with the program are not included.*

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

To qualify for the Laurie Pallett/Metalworks Institute Scholarship, an applicant must: be a Canadian citizen or landed immigrant; be a resident of Mississauga; have obtained an OSSD with a grade point average of 70% or higher; meet Metalworks Institute’s program eligibility requirements.

2. Attach a short essay (maximum of 2 pages) detailing why you feel the arts are important to our community and how you feel you can make a difference;

5. Attend an academic interview
