To qualify for the Metalworks Institute *Children's Aid Society Scholarship*, an applicant must: be a Canadian resident, meet all requirements for one of Metalworks Institute's diploma programs; meet enrollment and attendance requirements; and, must have been a Youth in Care with Children's Aid within Ontario, or currently in government care.

2. Provide a copy of your high school transcript
3. Provide a reference letter from your case worker

DISBURSEMENT SCHEDULE
